Colorado Avenue Esplanade Project

Description: *Realignment of Main Street Begins*

Dear Neighbor,

One of the major benefits from the Colorado Avenue Esplanade Project will be the realignment of Main Street so that it curves to meet 2nd Street directly.

The key advantage of this new configuration is removing a signalized intersection at Colorado Avenue and Main Street, which traffic designers believe will move traffic more efficiently.

First Signs of Realignment:

To start this major undertaking, the contractor will place K-rail (concrete barriers) running north-south along Main Street beginning Monday, September 14. Once this is done, left turns from westbound Colorado Avenue to southbound Main Street will be prohibited, so allow extra time for your travel using Colorado Avenue.

During the realignment of Main Street, one sidewalk from Main Street to Colorado Avenue will remain open at all times.

Project Remains on Schedule:

The Colorado Avenue Esplanade project remains on schedule for a 12-month construction period.
