Colorado Avenue Esplanade Project

Description: *Repaving North Side of Colorado Avenue*

Dear Neighbor,

To flip westbound vehicle traffic to its permanent location along the Esplanade—the north side of Colorado Avenue—workers will grind off the top layer of the north side lanes and add a new layer of asphalt.

Beginning on Friday night, November 6, workers will begin the process of grinding away the old layers of asphalt, beginning at Ocean Avenue, continuing to 4th Street. Westbound vehicle traffic will be unaffected, as will 2nd Street traffic.

Continuing on Saturday, November 7, workers will prepare the subgrade for new asphalt and will begin paving from 4th Street to Ocean Avenue.

On Saturday night, it will be necessary to close the north bound and the south bound lanes on 2nd Street and Main Street at Colorado. Local access to businesses and the Santa Monica Place valet will be open on 2nd Street from Broadway to Colorado.

We have chosen these construction times so that the least number of businesses and their customers would be affected.
