Colorado Avenue Esplanade Project

Description: *Rebuilding Ocean-Colorado Intersection*

Dear Neighbor,

Beginning Friday, February 26, workers will start reconstructing the Ocean Avenue/Colorado Avenue intersection by beginning work on the east side of the intersection near Tongva Park. We expect this work to last two weeks. We anticipate that reconstruction of the entire intersection will require one month.

During work on the east side, lanes through the intersection will be reduced; however, northbound and southbound traffic will have access to the intersection at all times.

Westbound Colorado Avenue at Ocean Avenue will be closed to through traffic for approximately 10 days. Please use alternative routes from Main Street and 2nd Street.

Construction of the west side of the intersection will follow and will also require approximately two weeks construction. Additional information regarding work on the west side of Ocean Avenue is forthcoming.

Pedestrians will have access to Santa Monica Pier at all times. During both phases, a left turn will not be allowed from northbound Ocean Avenue into the pier entrance.

The Colorado Avenue Esplanade remains on schedule for an April 2016 opening.

Things to Know:

- Reconstructing the Ocean Avenue/Colorado Avenue intersection begins on the east side of the intersection on Friday, February 26.
- Lanes on Ocean Avenue will be reduced. At least one northbound and one southbound lane will be open at all times.
- Pedestrians will have access to the pier at all times.
- During both phases of intersection reconstruction, left turns from northbound Ocean Avenue into the pier entrance will not be allowed.
