

# Moving?



## Temporary No Parking Signs

**VISIT CITY HALL PERMIT CENTER (see reverse for map):**

Once your moving date is solidified, reserve on-street parking for your moving truck by obtaining Temporary No Parking signs at City Hall's Permit Center. Signs must be posted, inspected and approved 24-hours prior to the parking reservation start time.

**ARRIVE PREPARED:**

Applications are processed immediately on a first-come first-served basis provided you bring proof of residency and make payment. It is necessary to know the parking meter numbers you wish to reserve, if any, and the size of your moving truck so we can determine your space requirements. Contact the Public Works Department (310-458-8737) if you are using a moving container, such as a portable PODS or Pack-Rat.

**POST SIGNS FOR INSPECTION:**

Call Santa Monica Police Department Traffic Services (310-458-8466) for inspection after signs are posted, and remove them when finished to avoid fines.

## Helpful Hints:

- Temporary No Parking signs are available to ensure adequate space for loading and unloading, visit [www.smgov.net/moving](http://www.smgov.net/moving).
- Be sure to know whether your truck has a ramp or lift, both will require more space.
- Proof of residency is required.
- Be advised that no parking zones, handicapped parking and loading zones may not be reserved.
- Valet zone meters may not be rented during Valet zone hours.
- In cases where you are requesting space in front of your neighbor's single-family home for more than one day, their notification is required.
- Oversized trucks may require an Oversized Load Permit to drive on city streets, please visit [www.smgov.net/oversize](http://www.smgov.net/oversize) for more information. If the oversized truck will park on city streets overnight, Oversize/Overnight Permit must be obtained from Parking Operations.

## One-day Temporary No Parking Reservation Fees:

	Metered Space*	Non-Metered Space
20 feet	\$79.21	\$76.21
40 feet	\$94.21	\$82.21
60 feet	\$109.21	\$88.21
80 feet	\$124.21	\$94.21
100 feet	\$154.21	\$100.21

Notes: Space may be reserved for a maximum of 2-days. Metered space fees include applicable meter rates for the duration of the restriction. \*Example assumes meter rate \$1/hr. between 9AM and 6PM. Meter rates \$2/hr. in Downtown and Beach zones. All space reserved in increments of 20-feet. Fees shown are valid between 7/1/15 and 6/30/15. Fee are adjusted July 1 each year.
