## Colorado Avenue Esplanade Project

### Description: *Night Work Near Bloomingdale's*

Dear Neighbor,

Night work near the Bloomingdale's south entrance will rebuild the ADA ramp at the northwest corner of 4<sup>th</sup> Street and Colorado Avenue while maintaining access during business hours.

The night work, scheduled for the week of June 8<sup>th</sup>, will demolish the apron leading to the sidewalk. Access to the sidewalk and Bloomingdale's will be maintained.

#### **Simultaneous Work**

Also during the week of June 8<sup>th</sup>, the contractor will pour a majority of the curb and gutter for the north side of the Colorado Avenue Esplanade, from 4<sup>th</sup> Street to 2<sup>nd</sup> Street.

The Colorado Avenue Esplanade project remains on schedule for a 12-month construction period. When it is complete, the Esplanade will provide a new gateway to Downtown Santa Monica, the Civic Center, the Santa Monica Pier, Palisades Park, and Tongva Park.
