

**FOLLOW THESE PRECAUTIONS IN ALL OPEN &
RECREATIONAL AREAS OF LOS ANGELES COUNTY
BETWEEN DUSK AND DAWN**

OUTDOORS:

- AVOID ACTIVITY IN THIS AREA between dusk and dawn when mosquitoes may be most active.
- APPLY MOSQUITO REPELLENT containing the active ingredient DEET when outside. Follow instructions carefully.
- WEAR PROTECTIVE CLOTHING (loose, light colored, long sleeve shirts and pants.)

AT HOME:

- MOSQUITO-PROOF YOUR HOME with tight fitting screens on windows and doors.
- ELIMINATE STANDING WATER around your property.
