NOTICE OF CANCELLATION

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Regular Meeting of the Landmarks Commission to be held at 7:00 PM on **Monday, May 11, 2020** has been **CANCELLED**.

We care about your health and safety, and we are working closely with the LA County Department of Public Safety to stop the spread of the novel coronavirus (COVID-19). Given the “Stay at Home” orders from California Governor Gavin Newsom, the City of Santa Monica is cancelling all public events, including the Landmarks Commission meeting on May 11, and extending facility closures through June 30. This means that all closures, including City Hall and City facilities (including beach parking closures and impacts on City services) are effective until June 30.
