Item 6A, STOA for 1626 California

Dear Chair Genser and Commissioners,

I'm writing to request a small but important correction to the STOA on 1626 California that is on the agenda for approval as item 6A.

One of the distinguishing features of this particular example of the vernacular California bungalow is the use of Tuscan columns on the front porch, and dentil-like trim. This is not typical of most bungalows, which use masonry piers and squared posts as porch supports. It is typical of the late phase of the bungalow style in which Colonial Revival elements appear. Therefore, I respectfully request that the property description add the phrase:

Add:

The Tuscan columns used for the front porch and dentil frieze are characteristic of incorporating Colonial Revival features in late California bungalows.
