NOTICE OF CANCELLATION

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the regular meeting of the Planning Commission to be held at 7:00 PM on **Wednesday, May 6, 2020** has been **CANCELLED**.

The next meeting of the Planning Commission will be a Special Meeting held via teleconference on Wednesday, May 13 (please refer to the May 13 Agenda for details on how to attend).

The City of Santa Monica has extended our local emergency and all orders until May 15.

We care about your health and safety, and we are working closely with the LA County Department of Public Safety to stop the spread of the novel coronavirus (COVID-19). Given the “Stay at Home” orders from California Governor Gavin Newsom, the City of Santa Monica is cancelling all public events, including the Planning Commission meeting on May 6, and extending facility closures through May 15. This means that all closures, including City Hall and City facilities (including beach parking closures and impacts on City services) are effective until May 15.
