NOTICE OF CANCELLATION

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the regularly scheduled Zoning Administrator hearing to be held at 10:30 AM on **Tuesday, April 14, 2020**, in the City Hall Council Chambers (1685 Main Street, Room 213), has been **CANCELLED**.

The City of Santa Monica has extended our local emergency and all orders until April 30.

We care about your health and safety, and we are working closely with the LA County Department of Public Safety to stop the spread of the novel coronavirus (COVID-19). Given the “Stay at Home” orders from California Governor Gavin Newsom, the City of Santa Monica is cancelling all public events, including the Zoning Administrator hearing on April 14, and extending facility closures through April 30. This means that all closures, including City Hall and City facilities (including beach parking closures and impacts on City services) are effective until April 30. As a reminder, please **STAY HOME**, practice physical distancing of at least 6 feet, wash your hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds, and avoid touching your face with unwashed hands.
