**List community activities in which you are involved:**

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In 2018, as an instructor at Santa Monica College, I had the privilege of working with community partners such as AJ Ali, the director of "Walking While Black: Love Is The Answer." A film that shares about actions steps one can take whether it be a community member and/or the law enforcement officials in the agency serving the community. SMCPD Chief Johnnie Adams was instrumental in assisting with the three screenings we had on the SMC Campus and one off-campus at the Santa Monica Baha'i Center. After each screening was an Q&A with invited guests from SMPD, SMCPD, LAPD, college administrators, and community activists. In addition, I've had the privilege of working directly with Chief Jackie Seabrooks and other community partners in the capacity of police/community relations. Several individuals were invited to an event Chief Seabrooks hosted as well as an event hosted by the RAND corporation. At Santa Monica College, there are plans to continue the efforts started in 2019 to continue the work whether in the current virtual space and when it is safe to continue in the physical space.

I've served on the Human Relations Council with former SMPD Captain Darrell Lowe and current SMPD Captain Thomas McLaughlin.
