These challenges included fatal shootings by SMPD, excessive force and gang intervention when Santa Monica gangs and Shoreline and Inglewood were involved in gang war. We have also promoted community understanding with Calvary Baptist Church in Santa Monica to promote a better community relation with SMPD and our community of Color. The willingness of these Chief's to open up to community input with some support from city council is reflected a lot in today what the the department has in place. However, there is still a lot that can be done and i would like to help with the support of the NAACP to see this thru.
