

RESOLUTION NO. 5283 (CCS)

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SANTA MONICA RECITING THE FACT OF THE ELECTION HELD IN SAID CITY OF SANTA MONICA ON THE 10TH DAY OF APRIL, 1979, AND ADOPTING THE STATEMENT OF RESULT OF VOTES CAST.

WHEREAS, a general municipal election was held and conducted in the City of Santa Monica, the Santa Monica Unified School District and Santa Monica Community College District in Los Angeles County State of California, on Tuesday, the 10th day of April, 1979, as required by law;

THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SANTA MONICA DOES RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That there were 65 consolidated voting precincts and that the total number of ballots cast was 27,303.

SECTION 2. That the following persons were elected members of the City Council for four-year terms:

WILLIAM H. JENNINGS, CHRISTINE EMERSON REED, and RUTH GOLDWAY YANNATTA

SECTION 3. That the following persons were elected members of the Board of Education and Governing Board of the Community College District for four-year terms:

JAMES BAMBRICK, FRED BETETA, CAROLE CURREY and ANN STUMPUS.

SECTION 4. That Proposition A, a proposed initiative charter amendment providing for a system of rent control in the City of Santa Monica, was adopted

Proposition B, a proposed charter amendment providing for a new, separate governing board for the Santa Monica Community College District, failed to be adopted.

Proposition C, a proposed charter amendment providing for particular modifications and personnel and employment practices, was adopted.

SECTION 5. That the following statement of the results of votes cast is to be entered into the minutes of the City Council meeting at which it is accepted by adoption of this resolution:

STATEMENT OF THE CITY CLERK

I, Joyce Snider, City Clerk of the City of Santa Monica hereby certify the following:

That at the General Municipal Election held April 10, 1979, as provided for by the Charter of the City of Santa Monica and the Elections Code of the State of California, there were 54 consolidated voting precincts established within the boundaries of the City of Santa Monica and eleven consolidated election precincts established within the Santa Monica Unified School District and the Santa Monica Community College District but outside the City of Santa Monica for a total of 65 voting precincts

That the absent voter ballots were canvassed by a board appointed by the City Clerk as provided for in the State of California Elections Code and that the official canvass was commenced by the City Clerk on April 12, 1979 and completed on April 13, 1979.

That the voting was done by electric vote recording equipment (IBM) in accordance with the provisions of the State of California Elections Code.

That there were 25,025 ballots cast within the City, 1,009 ballots cast outside the City, all within the Santa Monica Unified School District and the Santa Monica Community College District and 1,269 absent voter ballots cast within the entire election jurisdiction for a total of 27,303 ballots cast.

That the following measures were voted upon:

Proposition "A". Shall Article XVIII of the City Charter be enacted to provide for a system of rent control in the City of Santa Monica?

Proposition "B". Establishment of separate board for Santa Monica Community College District. Shall the Charter of the City of Santa Monica be amended to provide for a new, separate governing board for the Community College District instead of having the same governing board for both the Santa Monica Unified School District and the Community College District?

Proposition "C". Personnel Charter Amendments. Shall certain amendments, as proposed, to Section 1110 of the Charter of the City of Santa Monica providing for particular modifications and personnel and employment practices, eliminating or clarifying references to gender, making certain wording changes, and correcting minor grammatical errors, be adopted?

Proposition A was adopted; Proposition B failed to be adopted;  
Proposition C was adopted.






