Calculating the Square Footage of Your Landscape Area

ALL CALCULATIONS SHOULD BE IN SQUARE FEET (ft²)

When calculating the landscape area, do not include impermeable hardscapes like sidewalks, driveways or patios unless you are removing this hardscape and replacing with plants and irrigation.

For rectangular areas, use the length times the width of the bed.
Area = Width x Length

For oval areas, use the length and the widest point of the width.
Area = 0.8 x Width x Length

For triangular areas, use the height at the tallest point and the width at the base of the triangle and then multiply those by half.
Area = 0.5 x Width x Height

If only installing drip around a tree and no other irrigation is upgraded, use the diameter of the canopy of the tree.
Area = (Diameter / 2)² x 3.14
