

Moving in Santa Monica?

If there is no parking space available on-site at the moving location you can reserve curbside parking spaces for a **moving truck** if you are able purchase and post the temporary no parking signs at the location **24 hours in advance** of the time and date you need reserved.

For PODS or moving containers please contact Public Works 310-458-8737

Process

1. VISIT SANTA MONICA CITY HALL 1685 MAIN STREET

with proof of residency and knowledge of how much space the moving truck will need, reservation time/date, and meter #s (if applicable).

2. **PURCHASE SIGNS** at the Transportation Counter. Staff will provide you with the signs and posting instructions.

3. **POST SIGNAGE** at the location and call SMPD Traffic Services (310-458-8466 x 4) to meet you onsite to inspect the signage at least 24 hours in a advance of the reserved time.

Temporary No Parking Reservation Fees

Application fee is \$72.91, Each sign is \$1.04

FAQs

Are temporary no parking signs required for a move within Santa Monica?

No. Purchasing temporary no parking signs (TNPS) is advised but not required. If not parking overnight (9:00 P.M. to 6:00 A.M.), moving vehicles are able to use street parking if they follow existing street regulations and are to find a legal open parking space. Active loading is allowed in alleys if 11 foot clearance can be maintained. Check alley signage, as some alleys limit loading to short periods of 30 minutes or less.

What type of curb space can I reserve?

Unmetered or metered parking can be reserved. For metered parking, it is necessary to know the meter numbers you wish to reserve. ADA parking spaces (blue curb), valet parking during operating hours, curbside bicycle lanes, loading zones, and red curb locations **cannot** be reserved.

For what period of time can I reserve street curb space?

Curb space for a moving truck can be reserved for a maximum of 72 hours.

What if someone parks in the curb space I reserved?

Once inspected by SMPD Traffic Services, the signs are tow-away zones. If you are not able to alert the person that they need to move their vehicle, please call SMPD Traffic Services (310-458-8466 x 4)

What other permits might be needed?

For larger vehicles, the moving truck operator may need to obtain an Oversize Load Permit to travel in Santa Monica. Please visit www.smgov.net/oversize for more information on what would be considered an oversize vehicle.
