



## THIRD STREET NEIGHBORHOOD HISTORIC DISTRICT CITIZEN PARTICIPATION COMMITTEE APPLICATION

### Purpose

Members of the Third Street Neighborhood Historic District Citizen Participation Committee are appointed by the Landmarks Commission. The authority of the Committee is to review and comment upon projects located within the Third Street Neighborhood Historic District. The Committee provides recommendations to the Landmarks Commission and does not have the authority to approve or deny any application request for any proposed alterations to properties located within the Third Street Neighborhood Historic District.

### Eligibility

Any City resident may be eligible for appointment on the Citizen Participation Committee. The Committee size is limited to five persons. The Committee Rules of Order adopted by the Landmarks Commission recommend that two members be district residents, one member be an at-large member who is a resident of the City, and no more than two members be Landmarks Commissioners.
