The Emission Reduction Plan (ERP) is an annual requirement for employers in the City of Santa Monica with 50 or more employees. The ERP includes information about how your employees get to and from work. The purpose and objective of the ERP is to help the City of Santa Monica proactively manage congestion, reduce automobile dependence, and enhance transportation choices through employee-specific automobile trip reduction plans. Therefore, the information provide is crucial, as it brings Santa Monica one step closer to becoming a sustainable city of wellbeing. Take these steps to ensure compliance with City regulation and play your role in making Santa Monica the best place to live, work, and play.

Designate and certify an Employee Transportation Coordinator (ETC) who will be responsible for administration of your Emission Reduction Plan.



2

Survey employees annually about how they get to work. You'll use these numbers to calculate Average Vehicle Ridership.



3

Average Vehicle Ridership (AVR) analyzes how many employees drive their vehicles to work.



4

Develop a commute plan that encourages employees to use more sustainable travel options.



5

Programs like parking charges, transit reimbursements, and telework policies are proven to be effective in changing transportation behavior.

Tell us your plan using either the online tools or old-school paper plans.
