Santa Monica Community Recycling Center will be closed until further notice effective June 15, 2019

The Santa Monica Community Recycling Center, commonly known as the Buyback Center, will close effective June 15, 2019, until further notice.

Curbside Recycling Will Continue as Scheduled

There will be no impact to curbside recycling collection for residential and commercial customers. The City will continue to collect and process all recyclables as usual. Santa Monica residents who wish to recycle empty California Refund Value (CRV) bottles and cans may continue to place their recyclables in their recycling containers.

Nearby Redemption Center Locations

Customers who want to redeem their CRV beverage containers for cash can bring their items to the nearest redemption centers at the following locations:

- Cheviot Hills – rePlanet Recycling Center at Von's, 9860 National Blvd., Los Angeles, CA 90034
- Culver City – rePlanet Recycling Center at Ralphs, 10772 Jefferson Blvd, Culver City, CA 90230

The City is in the process of identifying an option to work with a recycling contractor on a month-to-month basis for processing recyclables during the short-term. Please note that there will be no immediate impact to solid waste rates.
