The City of Santa Monica cares about your health and safety. If you have had to close or downsize your restaurant to prevent the spread of COVID-19, we encourage you to donate excess produce to one of the following local food banks or non-profits in the Santa Monica area.

PATH (People Assisting the Homeless).

Location and Hours: 2346 Cotner Ave, West Los Angeles, 8 am - 5 pm Monday-Friday.

Types of food donations accepted: Fresh produce and pre-prepared food from commercial kitchens.

Regis House Community Center.

Location and hours: 2212 Beverly Blvd, Los Angeles, CA 90057

Types of food donations accepted: Both non-perishables and pre-prepared food but they are not accepting donations until April 8th. Restaurants can contact them closer to the date with any questions.

Salvation Army.

Location and Hours: 505 Olympic Blvd., Santa Monica; every day of the week 8am-10pm.

Types of food donations accepted: Only non-perishables, no pre-made food.

Location and hours: 204 Hampton Drive, Venice. Modified food pantry hours during COVID-19 crisis: Monday 10am-12pm, Tuesday 12pm-3pm, Friday, 12pm-3pm.

Types of food donations accepted: Non-perishables and fresh produce- not accepting any pre-prepared food.

Upward Bound House.

Location and Hours: 1104 Washington Avenue, Santa Monica, 8:30am-4:30pm Monday-Friday.

Types of food donations accepted: All non-perishables, frozen food, and prepared food that has been cooked in a commercial kitchen (prepared food not cooked in a commercial kitchen will not be accepted).

Westside Food Bank.

Location and Hours: 1710 22nd St, Santa Monica, temporary Business Hours during the Safer at Home order: Monday-Thursday, from 7 am to 2 pm.

Types of food donations accepted: They are no longer accepting individual food donations; individuals can make financial donation instead, but corporate food donations are still accepted.
